The 2020 Hawkeye Classic Versatility Ranch Horse Challenge Jackpot Guidelines

Exhibiting: The Hawkeye Classic Versatility Ranch Horse Challenge will consist of the Versatility Ranch Horse Riding, VRH Trail and VRH Conformation classes, where the scores will determine the placings.

Exhibitors: Horses must be AQHA Registered. Exhibitors must be AQHA Members and Amateur or Youth exhibitors must hold an Amateur Card or Youth Card. Those horses shown in the Amateur & Youth classes must meet AQHA ownership guidelines or present lease paperwork.

Scoring System: The following point system will be used to determine the class score based on entries in the class. *Example:* If there are 30 entries in a class, first place will earn 30 points, second will earn 29 points, third will earn 28 points, etc., and through 30th place will earn 1 point.

<u>Classes</u>: Exhibitors are required to show in Versatility Ranch Horse Riding, Versatility Ranch Horse Trail and Versatility Ranch Horse Conformation.

Judges: Four judges will judge the classes. The four scores from the three Versatility Ranch Horse Classes will be used to determine final placings. Entrants must show to all four judges to qualify for division champions.

Entry Fees: The Entry Fee for the Hawkeye Classic Versatility Ranch Horse Challenge is \$100, which includes the Open division, the Amateur division or the Youth division for one horse/rider combination. To be eligible for both the Open & Amateur Divisions, \$100 must be paid for each division. To be eligible for the Youth Division a separate \$100 entry fee must be paid. Entries must be made prior to the Versatility Ranch Horse Classes Friday, July 3, 2020. All horses must have a stall. (NO JUMP OUTS.) 75% of each entry fee will go towards the purse of each division accordingly. Any and all sponsorship money will be added to the jackpot.

Tack/Attire: Hawkeye Classic Versatility Ranch Horse Challenge exhibitors will present their horses in ranch/working tack. (Silver on the tack, hoof polish and tail extensions are discouraged.) For the Versatility Ranch Horse Conformation (halter) class, exhibitors are encouraged to show in a rope halter or plain leather halter and plain lead. Working attire is encouraged for all exhibitors.

Prize money: High point in all three divisions will be determined by the highest point earning combination from the three Versatility Ranch Horse classes. Monies will be awarded to the Top Five competitors in each of the three divisions.
